PIPING RULES

1. All competitors to be members of the Piping and Dancing Assn of NZ (Membership application forms available on the day).
2. To be conducted under the rules of the Piping & Dancing Assn of NZ.
3. Competitors must report to board stewards prior to each event otherwise their right to compete may be forfeited.
4. Competitors must compete in same order as the draw or as directed by the board steward and should have pipes tuned in readiness.
5. Tuning time on the board must be kept to an absolute minimum (not to exceed 3 minutes)
6. All competitors must be suitably attired in Highland Dress when competing and at the prize giving.
7. Competitors to play in one grade only. Small music grade is also the competitor's Piobaireachd grade.
8. Paeroa entry fees and prize money are noted above.
9. Day winners will receive monetary point's prizes for each of the four Piping Tri-Series days.
10. Piping Tri-Series winners will receive their prizes at the completion of the Hamilton competition July 2010 (Date to be confirmed). All winners must be personally present to receive their prize.
11. The Judges' decisions will be final.
12. Tri Series points will be awarded by competitors taking their best three weekend results across the four competitions.
13. Piping Tri-Series competitions will be held Friday 1st January 2010(Waipu), Saturday 13th February 2010 (Paeroa), Saturday 3rd April 2010(Hastings)and July 2010(Hamilton, Date to be confirmed))
